The Mauritius Tourism Promotion Authority (MTPA) is proceeding with a Request for Proposals online and is inviting potential local and international Consultants to submit their proposals through the Government eProcurement System for **Content Creation, Development & Implementation** for the forthcoming high season tourism campaign.

3. To be able to participate in the exercise, Bidders must be **registered on the eProcurement System and must possess the Digital Signature Certificate (DSC)**. **Bidders are encouraged to apply for the DSC well in advance to avoid any hindrance in submitting proposals.**
4. **Proposals** must be submitted online on the eProcurement System at latest by **Monday 29 August 2022 up to 13:00 hrs (Local Time)**.
5. Bidders are encouraged to submit their bids online well before the submission deadline and not wait for the last moment to avail of any assistance that may be required from the Procurement Policy Office Helpdesk. The Procurement Policy Office has set up a Help Desk that provides technical support to users of the e-Procurement system.
6. Consultants who have submitted proposals online by the closing date and time shall decrypt and re-encrypt their proposals as from **Monday 29 August 2022 from 14:01 hrs Mauritian time till Tuesday 30 August 2022 up to 14:00 hrs, Mauritian time.**
7. Proposals received will be opened online in the presence of the Consultants' representatives who choose to attend at the address given hereunder on **Tuesday 30 August 2022 at 14:01 hrs.**
